

BOYCOTT CABLEVISION

EATV, a non-profit public access television group, is calling for a consumer boycott of local utility monopoly Cablevision of Chicago due to continued violations of the cable tv franchise agreement with Evanston. These include deceptive billing practices, denial of first amendment rights to public access users, failure to provide a home health, safety and security system, and other possible technical violations due to the quality of their service.

EATV (Evanston Alternative Television) and other community members are asking Cablevision subscribers to withhold payment on their bills for a minimum of one month. All cable complaints should be directed to the City's cable office at 866-2935 for documentation.

Since system activation in March of 1983, Cablevision has subjected Evanston residents to: negative service and billing response, construction delays and related fines which have not been paid, a downward re-negotiation of public access commitments, and the censorship of the local progressive news program E.A.T.V.
